
Total Canna Profile™

Total Canna Profile[™] (TCP)

The MyDx Total Canna Profile[™] (TCP) is a proprietary cannabis index based on a set of algorithms and associated data resulting from using the MyDx handheld analyzer and mobile app. TCP senses and reports a profile of Cannabinoids, Terpenes and other elements & characteristics of the cannabis sample. The TCP provides a user with the ability to find a cannabis strain that works for them and correlate it with feeling.



Personal Profile – Every person reacts differently to a given cannabis strain. The question "What is the best Cannabis" can only be answered from the perspective of the individual consuming the Cannabis, their specific neuro-chemistry, and their mental state at the time of consumption. A sedative to one person can be a stimulant to another. The Personal Profile allows the user to add their own experience to the TCP, allowing a customization of the scientific research.

In this way, uniquely the MyDx Analyzer provides an access to the age-old questions; "How Will This Sample Make **Me** Feel" or "What Will It Help **Me** Relieve"?
